

Local students going on mission to Mexico

Twenty fourth- and fifth-graders, accompanied by several parents, will take a trip to Rancho el Milagro, an orphanage housing 30 to 40 Mexican children in Ensenada, Mexico.

The children will leave on July 20, traveling with the group SURGE, sponsored by Cross Timbers Community Church. They will spend a week playing games and running a vacation Bible school for the orphans.

The cost of the trip is \$400 for each participant, and the students are being challenged to raise the money themselves.
