Volunteer Handbook & Policy Manual

Purpose

- To be used for any age group, any campus, any NextGen volunteer
- Will be supplemented by an age-specific Training Manual
- Blair to own the re-vamp

Core Values

- Descriptions will be whittled down and language will be changed
- Will be prominently displayed upfront
- Our *strategy* is that we're leveraging the influence of the parents and the impact another adult or teenager can have on a child; this is not a core value
- Living Connected is the NextGen strategy that allows the other three values to work

Safety & Security

- It's our mindset—the lens through which we see all other things
- It's part of a volunteer's job description, a very important part

Framing Volunteering in Orientation

- You're working for The King; because of that you need to be on time, take safety and security very seriously, and remember Jesus is ultimately who you're serving
- All four of these core values cannot happen if you're not on time, prepared, consistent, dedicated, etc.
- Hold yourself accountable to excellence
